Easter Bunny Hat



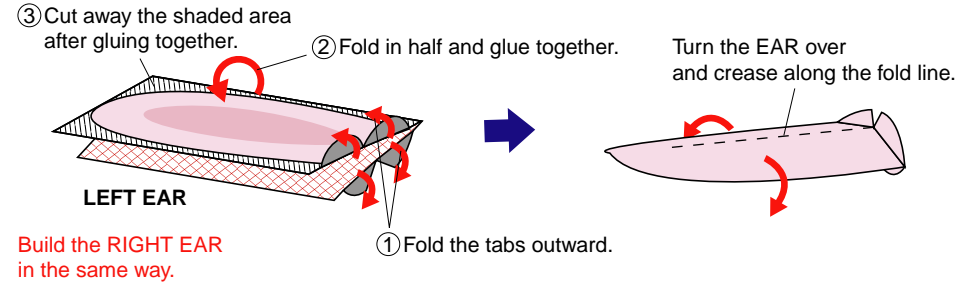
Easter is celebrated each year on the first Sunday after the first full moon after the vernal equinox. The name "Easter" is thought to come from "Eostre", the Germanic goddess of spring. Easter is widely celebrated in commemoration of the resurrection of Christ, and of the coming of spring.

In the spring, rabbits give birth to large litters. As a result, rabbits have been seen as symbols of life and prosperity since ancient times, and have often played important roles in spring festivals. Tradition has it that on Easter a rabbit called the Easter Bunny delivers Easter Eggs, a symbol of birth and creation.

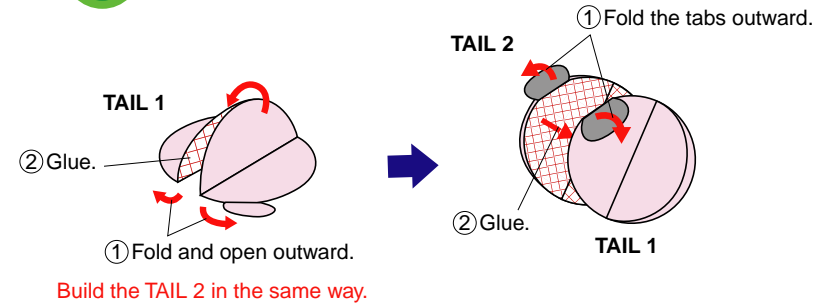
Note: this hat is sized for an adult. To make a child-sized hat, print the pattern reduced to about 85%.

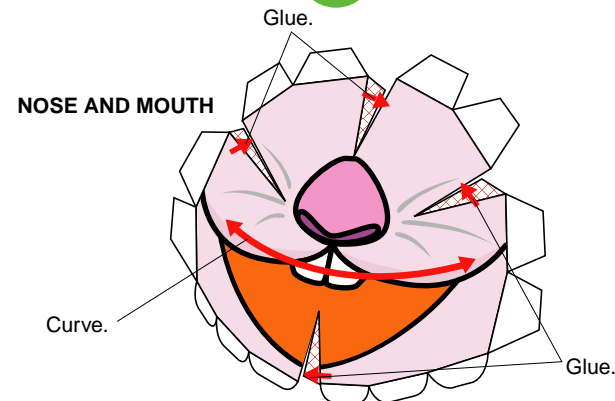

Build the TAIL 2

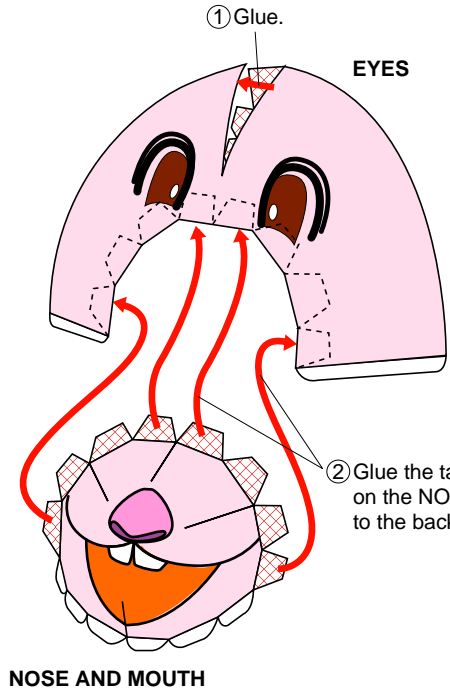


Build the NOSE AND MOUTH 3

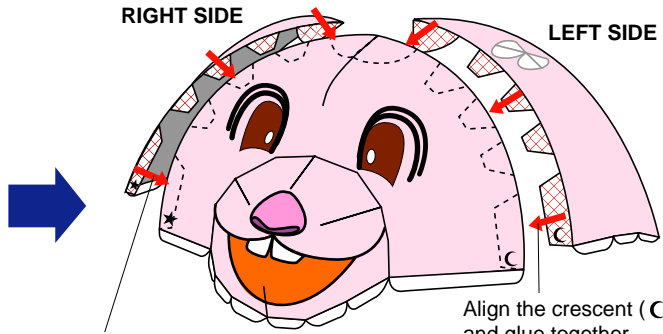

Put it all together 4

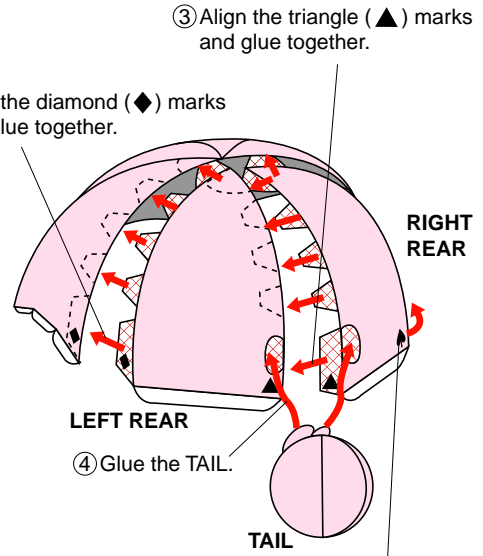


② Glue the tabs on the NOSE AND MOUTH to the back of the EYES.



Align the star (★) marks and glue together.

Align the crescent (C) marks and glue together.

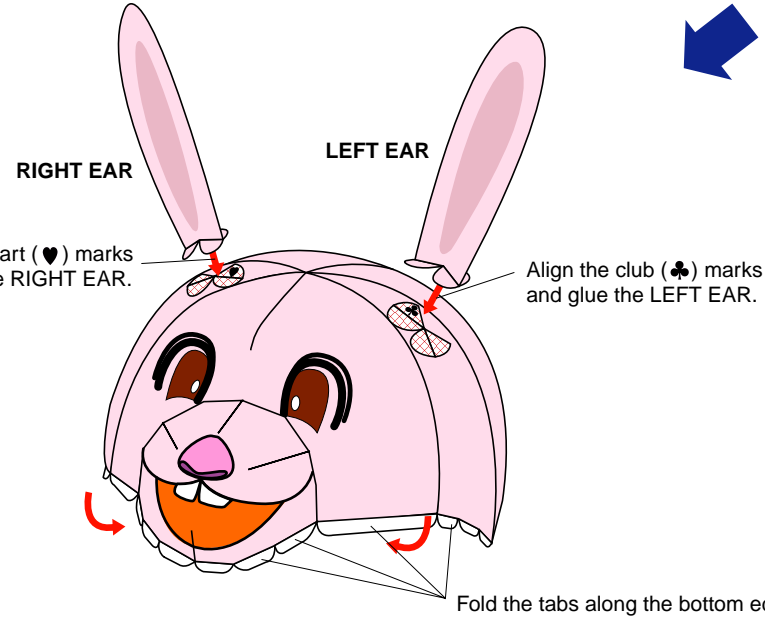


③ Align the triangle (▲) marks and glue together.

① Align the diamond (◆) marks and glue together.

④ Glue the TAIL.

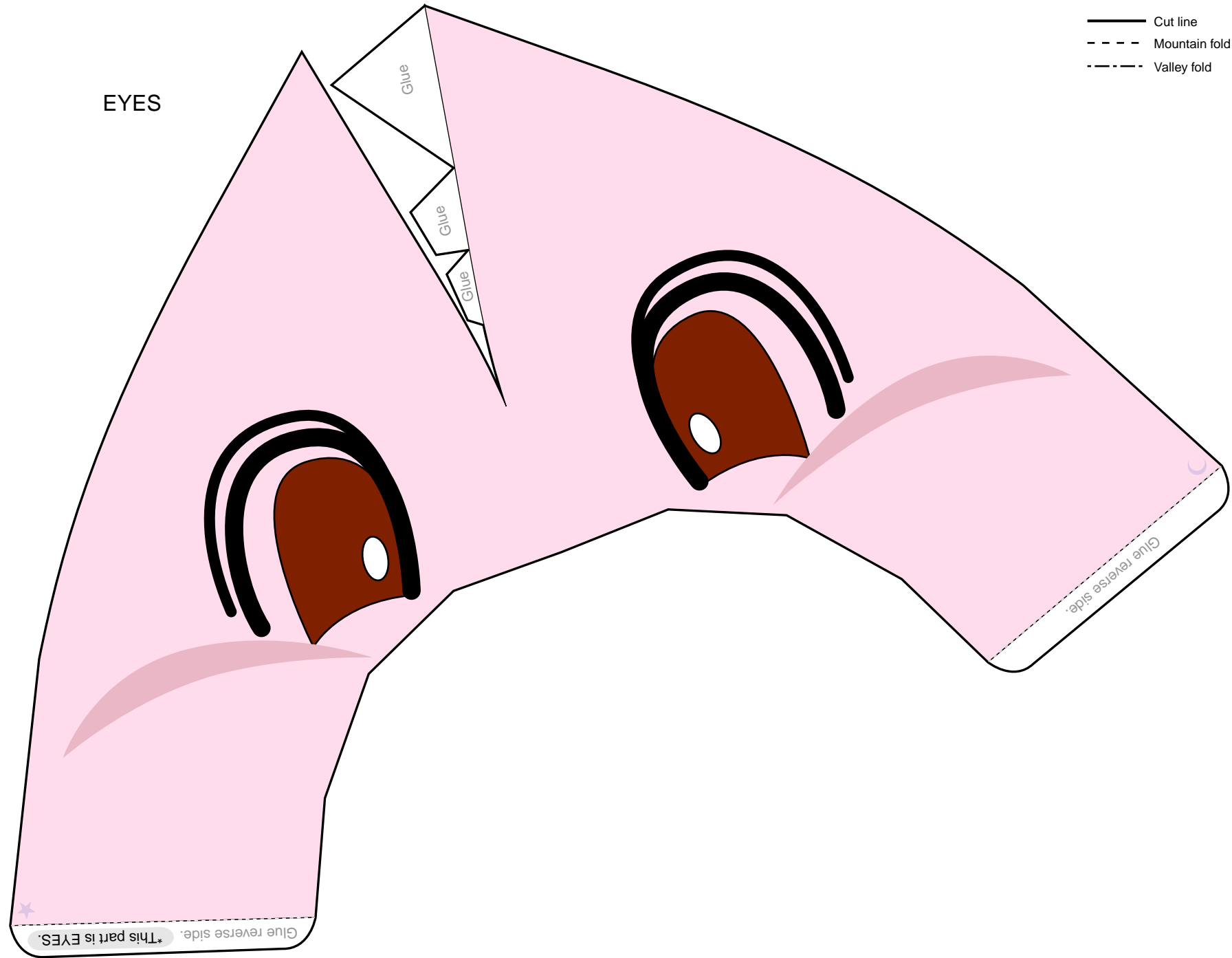
② Align the spade (♠) marks and glue together.



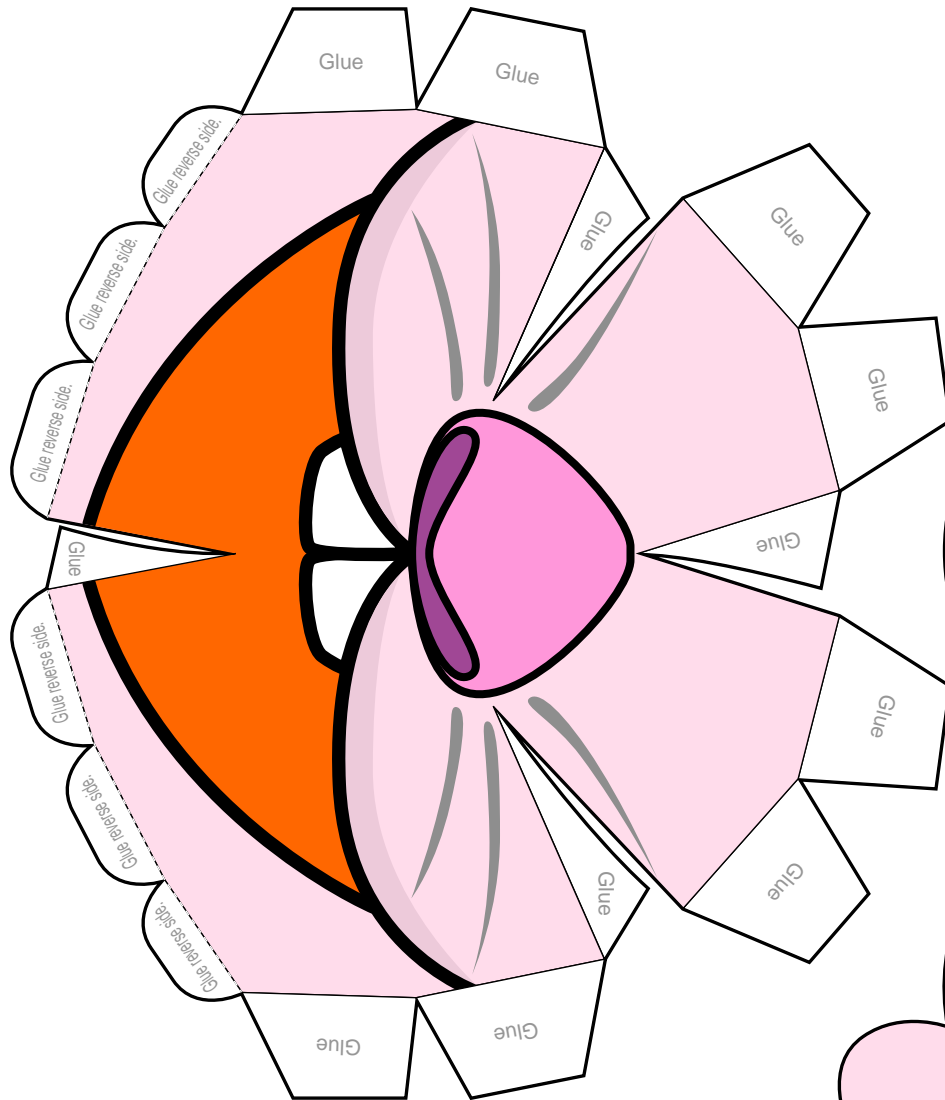
Align the heart (♥) marks and glue the RIGHT EAR.

Align the club (♣) marks and glue the LEFT EAR.

Fold the tabs along the bottom edge inward and glue.



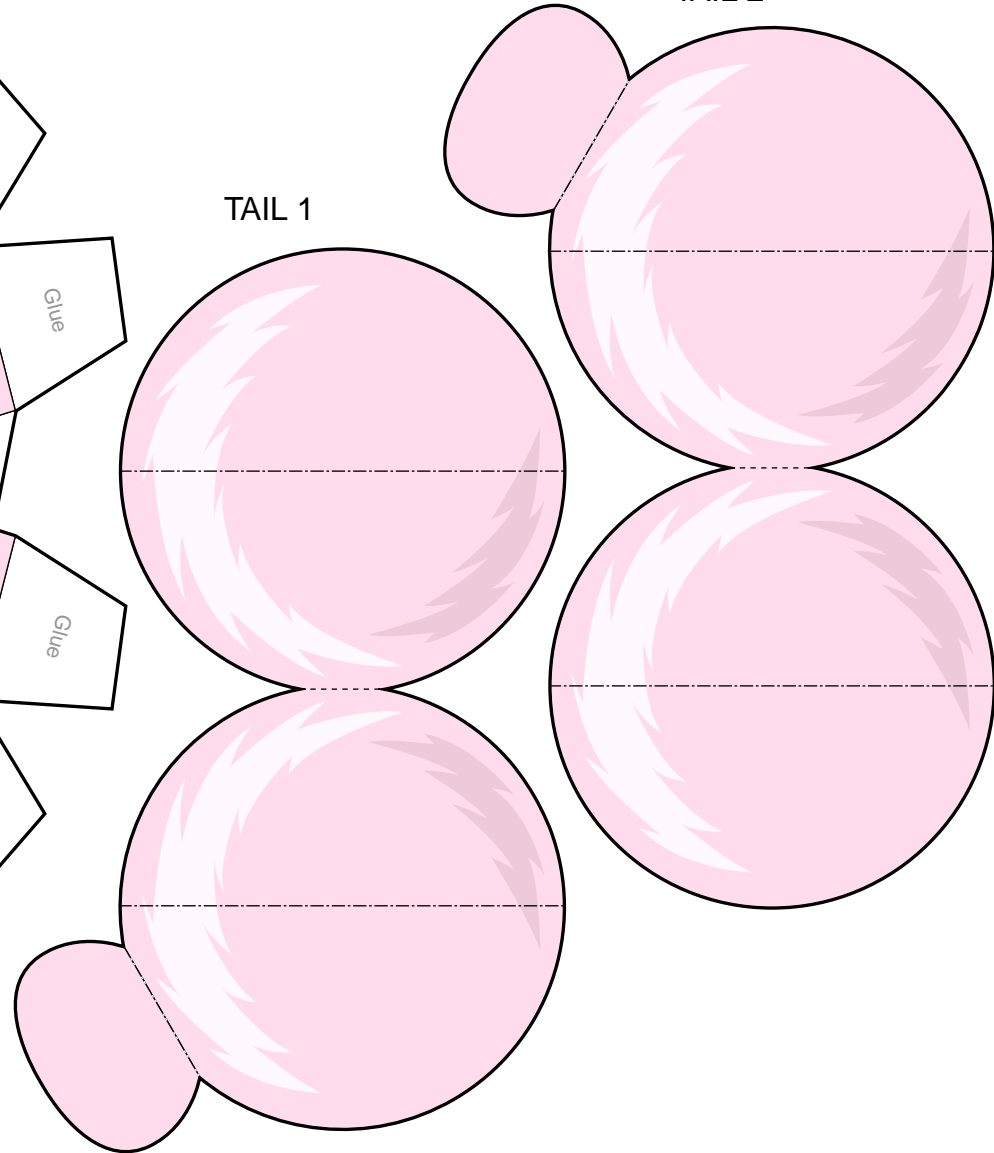
NOSE AND MOUTH

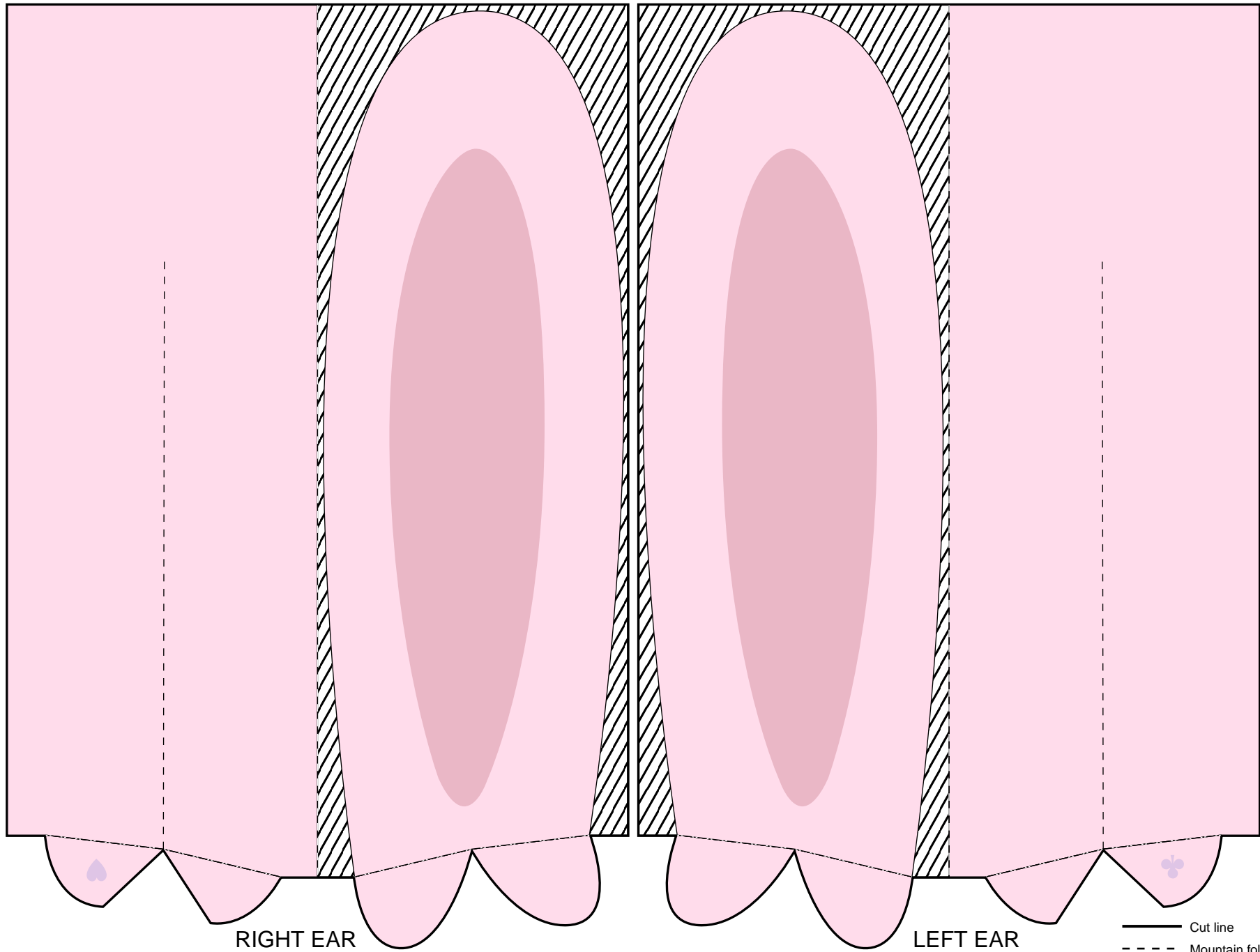

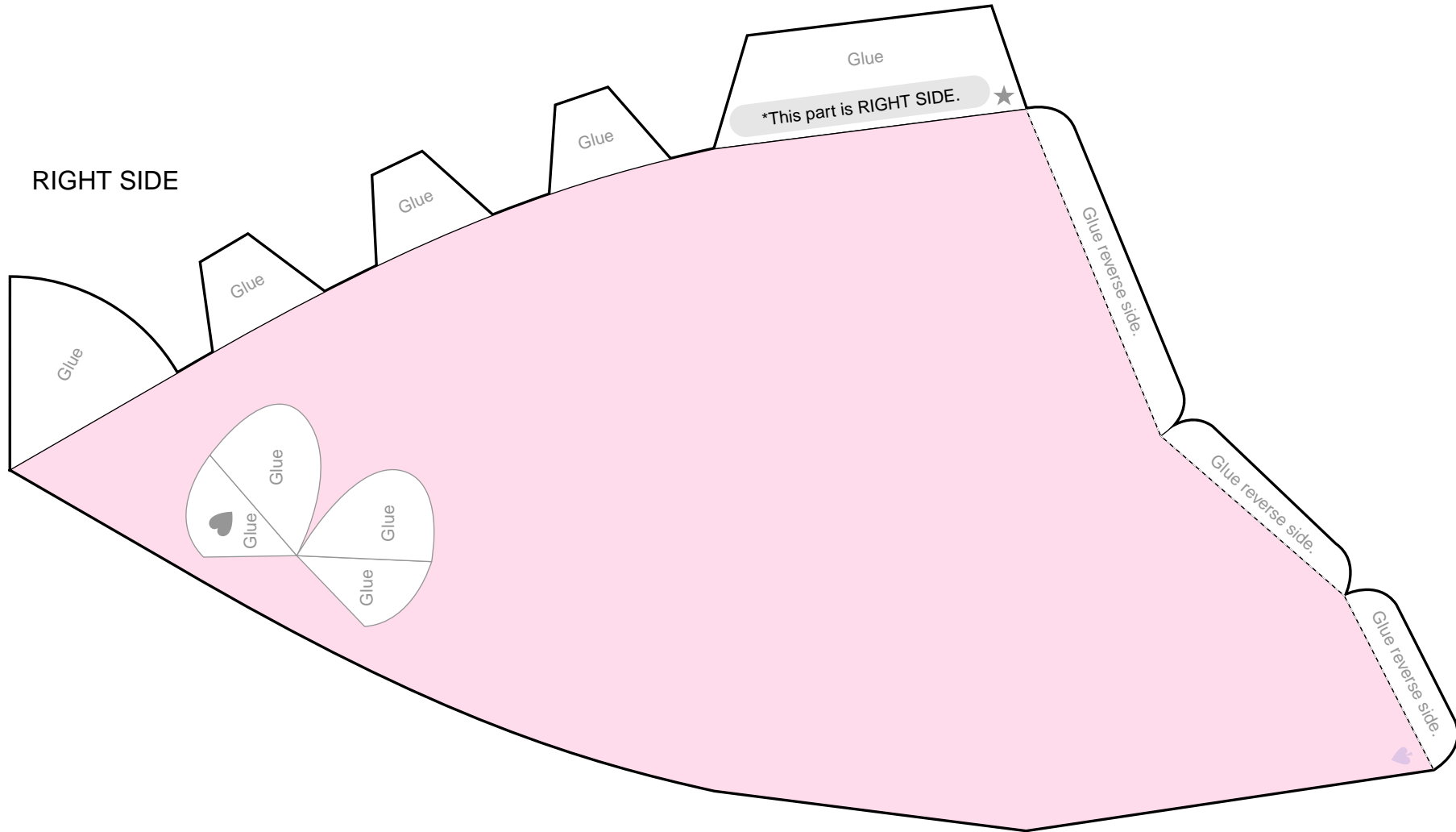

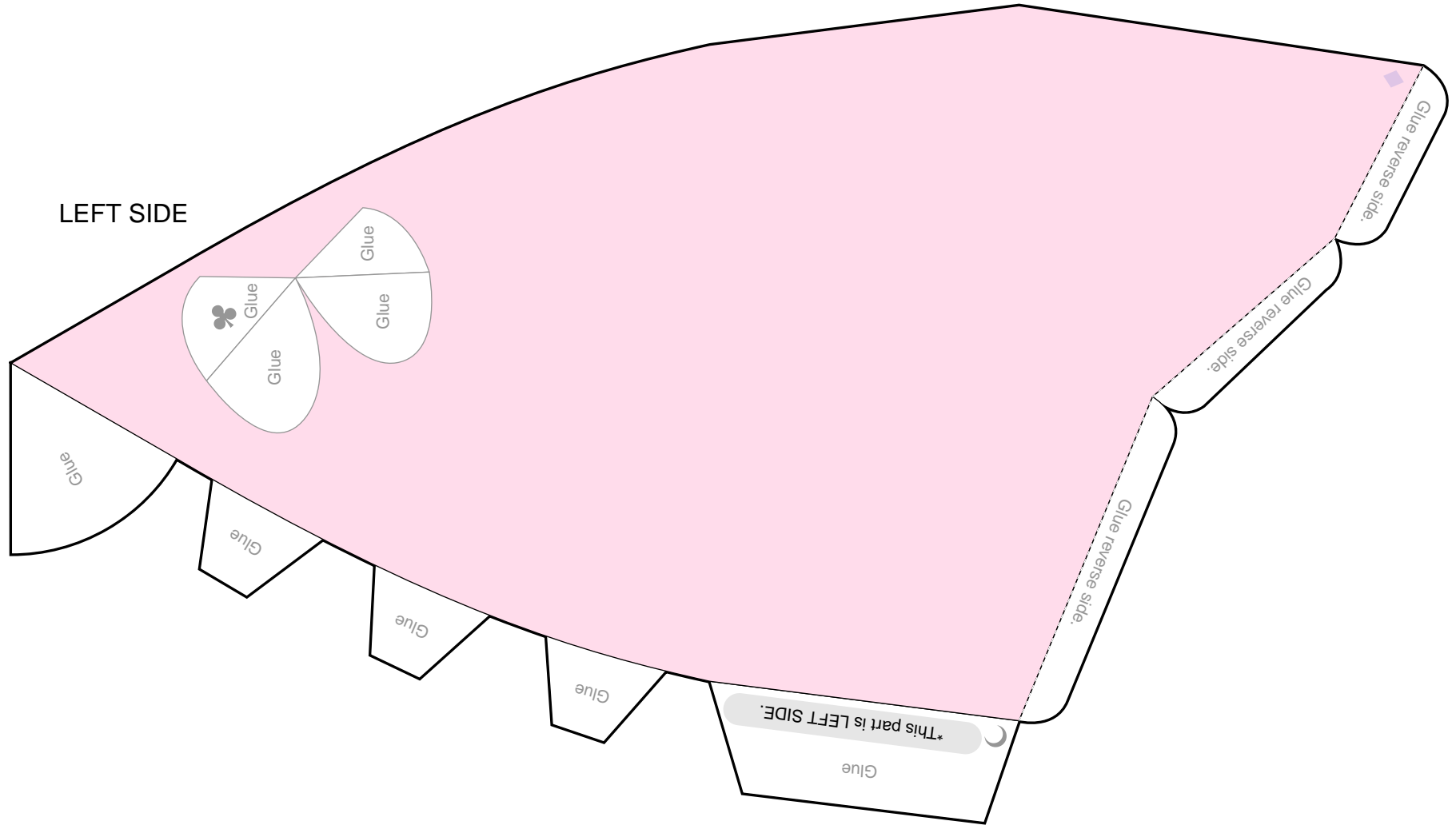
