
The Cretaceous Period began about 136 million years ago, and lasted until the dinosaurs' extinction, about 64 million years ago. Many different dinosaurs lived in this period of time.

These dinosaurs include the plant-eating iguanodon, which lived in the forest; the triceratops, which had three horns on its head; and the ankylosaurus, which used the bony growth on its tail to protect itself from enemies. The tyrannosaurus was the largest meat-eating dinosaur. It is thought that the tyrannosaurus was fastmoving, and used its speed to bring down prey. Truly the tyrannosaurus can be called the king of the dinosaurs.


