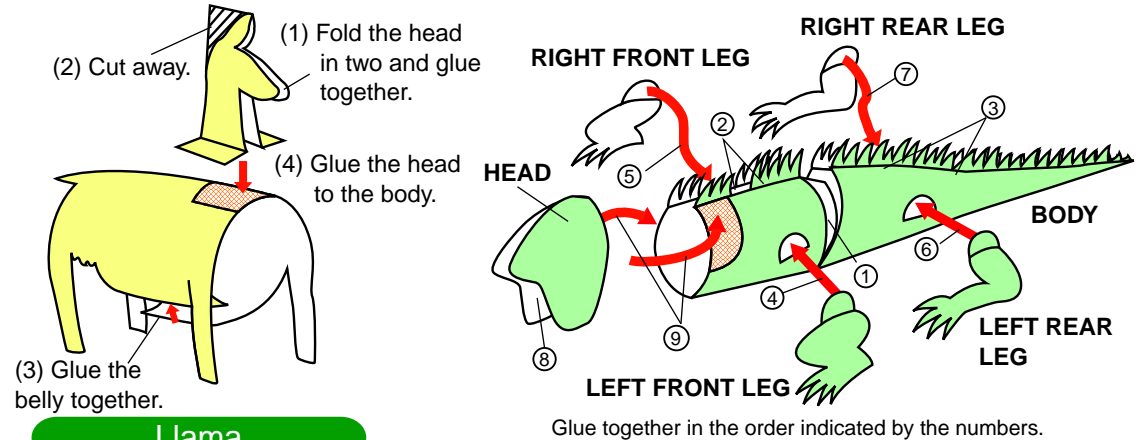


The South American continent extends from a region near the equator on the north to down near the Antarctic on the south, and is populated by a large number of different animals.

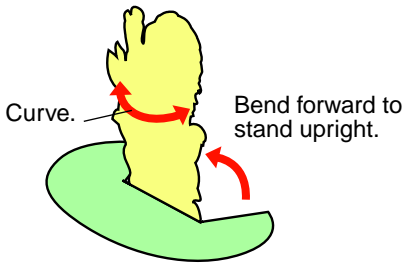

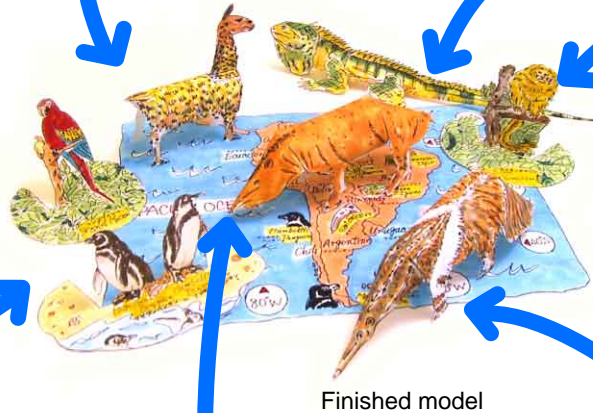

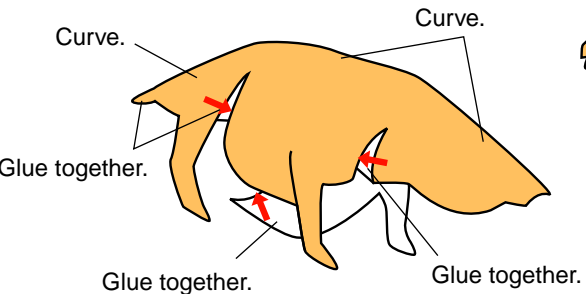

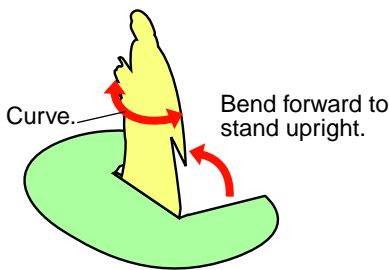

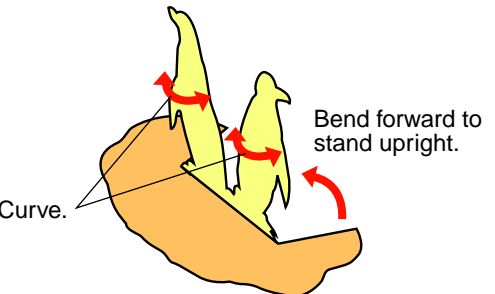

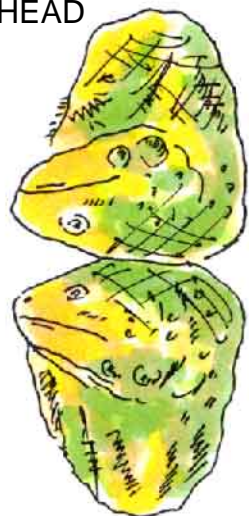

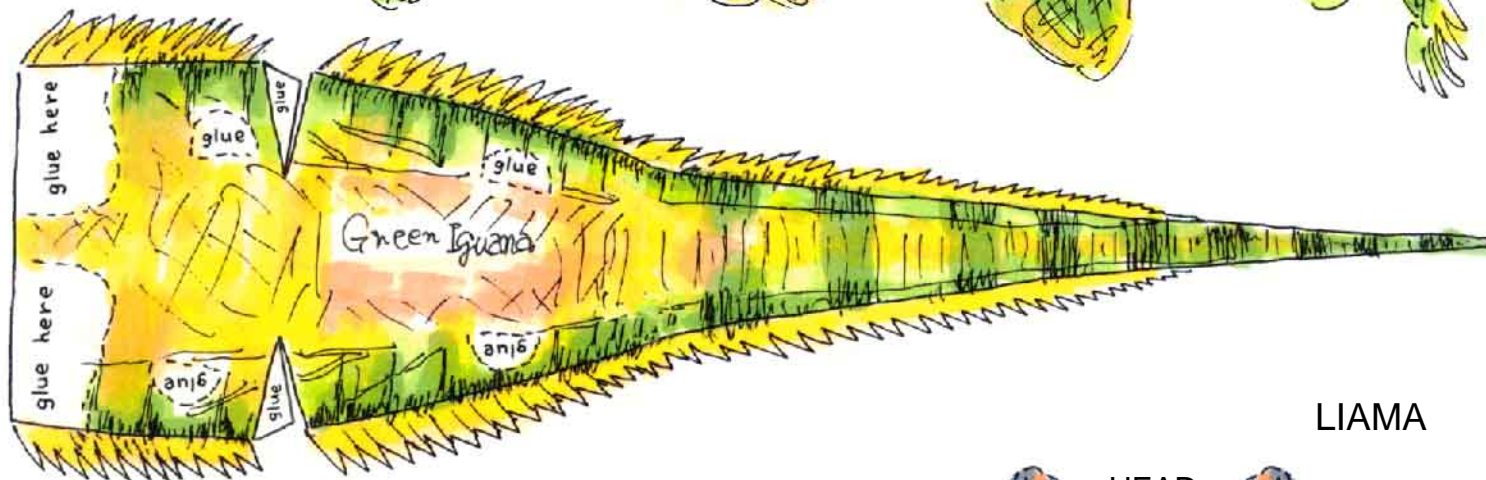

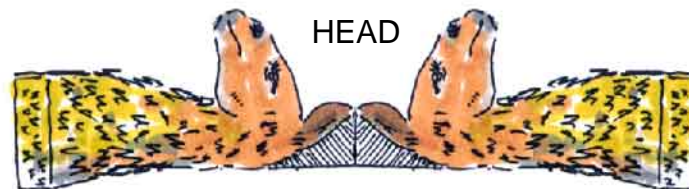

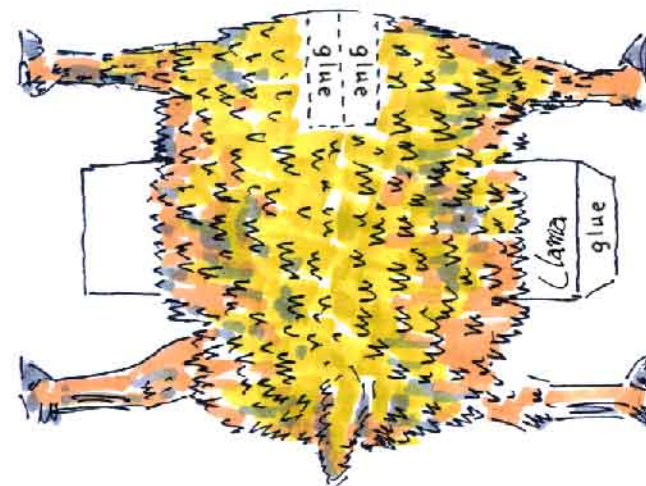

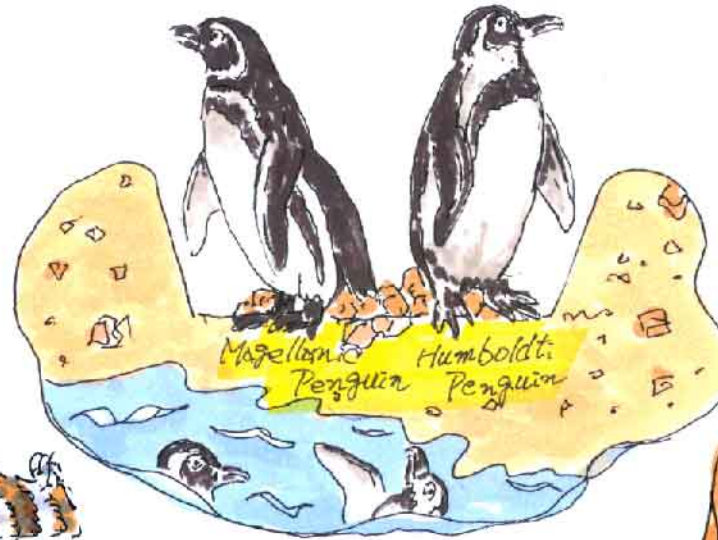
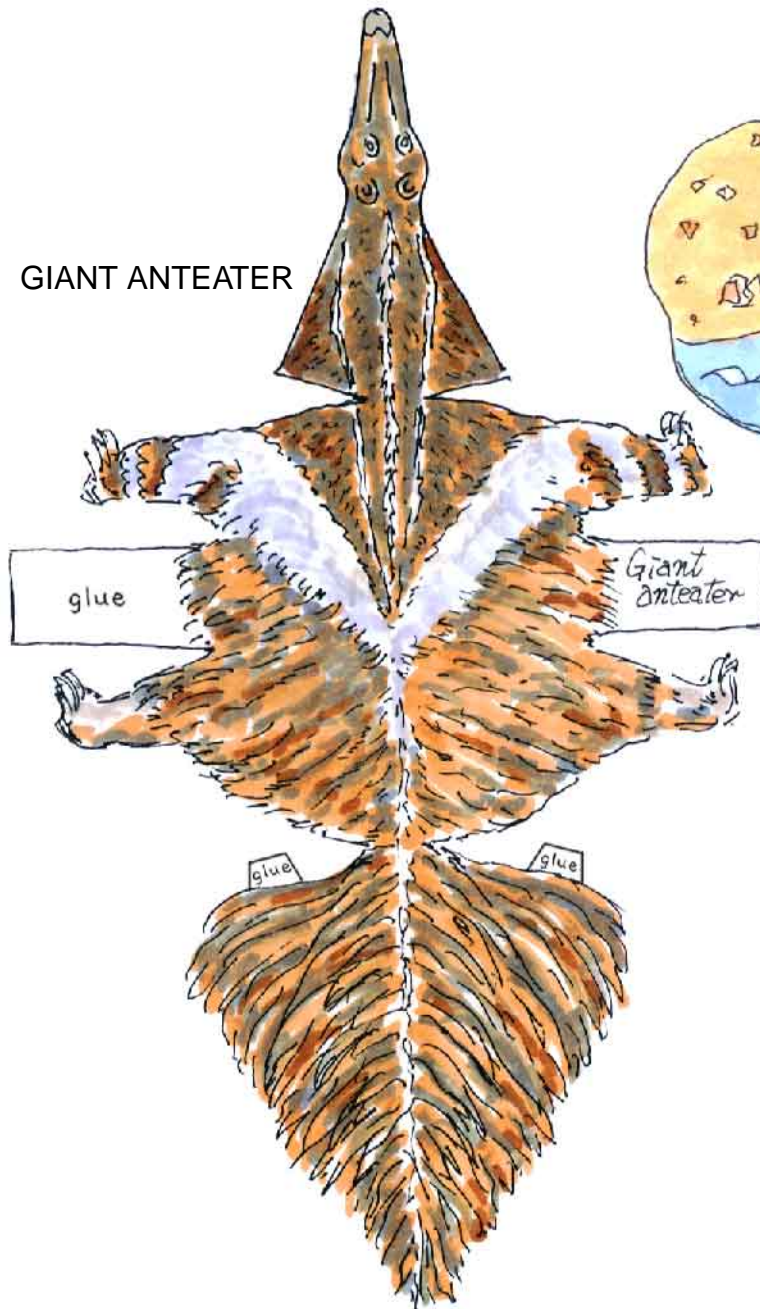
